

SUMMER SCHOOL 2014

8th GRADE SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

- Available at all high schools except Crooms.
- Limited bus transportation available.
- The program is designed for 8th grade students who have:
 - 1) Less than a 2.0 grade point average (required if students do not pass 8th grade).
 - 2) Received a level 1 and/or 2 on 7th grade FCAT in math and reading.
 - 3) Been retained 2 or more times.
- Registrations are available through the guidance department. Students eligible for this program have already been given an information packet.
- Students successfully completing the 6 week program will earn 1 high school credit towards graduation.
- The first nine weeks of the 9th grade content courses including algebra, language arts/reading, and/or science will be covered during the 6 week program. The program also works to assist students with the transition to high school.



SUMMER VIRTUAL CLASSES

- Students desiring to take a virtual course this summer need to register by the end of May.
- Counselors are not on campus over the summer to approve courses.
- General information and a course offerings are available at the Seminole County Public Schools website. Virtual school information and contact numbers can be found by clicking on the “schools tab” and then “virtual”.
- Make sure to select (SCVS) Seminole County Virtual School for your registration.
- Eighth grade students may go ahead and take the Personal Fitness course (required for graduation) to open up more space in the schedule next year (1501300).
