Testing and Summer Boot Camp – Information Sheet

EOC ASSESSMENTS OVERVIEW

ALGEBRA 1

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) requires that students in the Class of 2015 and after earn a Level 3 or higher (Scale Score 399-475) on the Algebra 1 End-of-Course (EOC) assessment. All students must earn credit for Algebra 1 in order to receive a standard high school diploma. If your student earns a final course grade of a “D” or “F” then your student should take the course in summer school to improve his/her grade point average (GPA).

If your student does not earn a proficient score on his/her EOC exam and/or does not pass the course, the following options will be made available for students:

1. If a student **DOES NOT PASS** the course(s) and **DOES NOT earn a Level 3 or higher** on the EOC exam, he/she should repeat the course in summer school or during the 2014-15 school year, and retake the EOC exam.
2. If your student **PASSES** the course(s) but **DOES NOT earn a Level 3 or higher** on the EOC exam, he/she may enroll in the Summer Boot Camp (June 23 – July 16), which will be offered at selected high schools (Oviedo, Lyman, Seminole, and Lake Howell). Your student will also need to retake the EOC exam at their zoned high school in the summer (Test Date: Algebra 1 – July 22).
 - Your student will be notified of the opportunity to register for the Summer Boot Camp as soon as your school receives EOC scores.
3. If your student **DOES NOT PASS** the course and **DOES earn a Level 3 or higher** on the EOC exam, he/she will earn a grade of “P” and will not need to retake the EOC exam. The “P” grade will satisfy the course credit requirement for graduation; however, your student may wish to retake the course in order to earn a letter grade that will positively impact his/her cumulative GPA.

BIOLOGY 1– Students must earn level 3 or higher in order to be eligible for Scholar’s diploma

1. If a student **DOES NOT PASS** the course(s) and **DOES NOT earn a Level 3 or above** on the EOC exam: Student should repeat the course in summer school or during the 2014-15 school year, and retake the EOC exam. Student will need to retake the EOC exam at their zoned high school in the summer (**Test Dates: Biology 1 –July 23**).
2. If your student **PASSES** the course(s) but **DOES NOT earn a Level 3 or higher** on the EOC exam: Student may enroll in the Summer Boot Camp June 23 – July 16, which will be offered at selected high schools (Oviedo, Lyman, Seminole, and Lake Howell). Student may also retake the EOC exam at their zoned high school in the summer (**Test Dates: Biology 1 –July 23**.)

U.S. HISTORY and GEOMETRY– Student’s scores from spring testing constituted 30% of the student’s grade. Summer Boot Camp will not be offered for U.S. History or Geometry.

1. Student who needs to make up the spring testing due to absence. Student will need to take the EOC exams at their zoned high school in the summer. (US History - **July 21 or Geometry – July 24.**)
2. Student wishes to retake the test in order to raise their overall grade in the course. Student will need to take the EOC exams at their zoned high school in the summer. (US History - **July 21 or Geometry – July 24.**)

SUMMER BOOT CAMP

Summer Boot Camp for **Algebra 1 and Biology 1 only**, will be held **June 23 – July 16**.

Monday-Thursday from 7:20am – 1:18pm. There will **not** be a boot camp for Geometry or U.S. History this summer. The EOC Boot Camp is designed to provide students support in specific skill areas in preparation for the EOC exams. There will be morning and afternoon sessions that will allow students to participate in more than one boot camp. Students who are already enrolled in summer school for Algebra 1, Biology 1, or Geometry will receive skill support through their summer school course.

TRANSPORTATION

Boot camp students may utilize the summer transition program bus stops. Shuttle service will be provided from summer school sites to the boot camp sites.
