

## High School Transition Program

The program is especially designed for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who have:

- Less than a 2.0 grade point average; or does not earn a promotion to high school
- Received a level 1 or 2 on FCAT Math and Reading; or
- Been retained 2 or more times; or
- Identified with a high “at-risk” score in EdInsight (grades, test scores, attendance, etc); or
- Recommended for additional support by their middle school principal
- \*The program benefits any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who qualifies in one of the above categories. Students who do not earn an overall 2.0 GPA at the end of the year are required to attend the program. However, there are many benefits for all identified students.
- Every high school in the district has the program this summer.
- Transportation: There is some bus transportation provided for each school.
- Breakfast and lunch are served at each site.
- Dates: June 1 – July 13<sup>th</sup> (Week of July 3-6 schools closed)
- No school on Fridays with the exception of June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Hours: 7:20 am – 1:18 pm

Students who earn a “C” or better in the Transition Program and meet all summer school attendance and behavior requirements will:

1. Earn one high school credit towards graduation; and
2. Earn a promotion to grade nine if their GPA is below a 2.0 for promotion.
3. Have a mentor through high school.
4. Get summer reading assignment done and have a positive grade on the GPA to start the freshman year.
5. Opportunity to earn scholarship hours to Seminole State College upon graduation.

The goal of the Transition Program is to prepare your child for academic success in high school. The first nine weeks of ninth grade content courses including algebra, language arts/reading, and science will be covered. Additionally, study and organizational skills will be taught to enable your student to be properly prepared for high school classes. This program will provide skill enhancement in the academic areas, a credit towards graduation, a mentor through high school, opportunity to earn scholarships to Seminole State College, and make “connections” to the campus and staff prior to the start of the school year.
