

## High School Transition Program - 2018

The program is especially designed for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who have:

- Less than a 2.0 grade point average at the end of the year for promotion to high school.
- Received a levels 1 or 2 on FSA testing. (Provides math and reading daily)
- Has been retained or identified as “at-risk” based on attendance, grades, test scores, etc.
- Recommended for additional support by school principal.

The High School Transition Program is available at every high school and benefits any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student in Seminole County who qualifies based on identified categories. Students who successfully complete the program will earn 1 credit towards graduation and receive the grade on their high school transcript. Students who fail to achieve a final GPA of 2.0 are required to attend the program to earn a promotion to grade 9.

### Transportation

There is limited bus transportation for each high school. The stops and times will be available ahead of start date and are identified on application.

### Summer High School Transition Dates/Hours

May 31 – June 28

No school on Fridays with the exception of 6/1

Hours: 7:20 am – 2:30 pm (breakfast and lunch served daily)

Benefits of the Program:

- 1) Allow students to earn a promotion who fail to meet required GPA.
- 2) Students can earn 1 full credit towards graduation.
- 3) Students will have a mentor in high school.
- 4) Students can earn college scholarship hours during high school.
- 5) Students will get summer math and reading assignments done.
- 6) Students will move ahead in math, language arts, science and have support in the transition to high school.
